

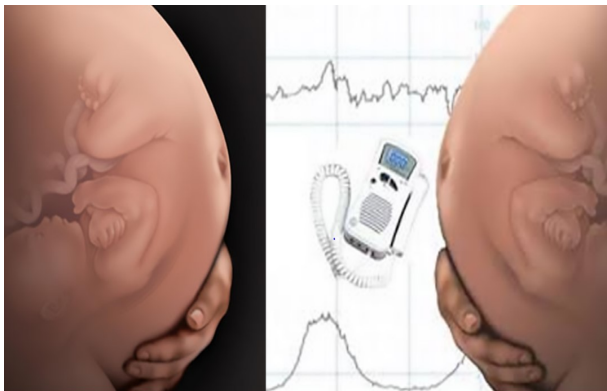


FETAL HEALTH SURVEILLANCE INSTRUCTOR WORKSHOP

- Apply principles of adult learning theory
- Develop and integrate adult learning principles and strategies to facilitate adult learning
- Construct facilitation techniques for a variety of learning environments
- Demonstrate the ability to teach/facilitate a short presentation
- Discuss strategies for supporting FHS guideline implementation and facilitation of workshops (various logistical issues related to planning and teaching the workshops)
- Facilitate FHS Provider Workshops across Saskatchewan with registration as a FHS Instructor with Canadian FHS Education Program through UBC CPD.
