OCT 2 | OVERVIEW OF CHRONIC PAIN

Presenters: Dr. Radhika Marwah | Dr. Susan Tupper

- Identify relevant priorities for assessment and management of chronic pain based on the patient's perspective and context.
- Establish a chronic pain care management plan, finding common ground with the patient in defining problems and priorities, and recognizing the roles of the patient, other healthcare providers and the family physician in each encounter.

OCT 16 | CANNIBIS/CANNIBINOIDS ROLE IN CHRONIC PAIN

Presenter: Dr. Hance Clarke

- Make clinical decisions regarding cannabis/cannabinoids for chronic pain informed by the best available evidence, past experience and the patient's perspective.
- Demonstrate clinical courage (rational risk taking) and comfort with uncertainty in approaching the use of cannabis/cannabinoids in chronic pain management.

OCT 23 | CHRONIC PAIN IN PEDIATRIC POPULATION

Presenter: Dr. Krista Baerg

- Establish goals of care for pediatric chronic pain in collaboration with patients and their families, which reflects the patient's values and goal for health and well-being.
- Work collaboratively with patients, their families, other health care colleagues and key stakeholders to provide comprehensive care to pediatric pain patients.

OCT 30 | MANAGEMENT OF DEPRESSION IN CHRONIC PAIN Presenter: Dr. Abhimanyu Sud

- Manage chronic pain patients with complex co-existing clinical and contextual issues including comorbid depression, often in conditions of uncertainty.
- Recognize and facilitate necessary transitions in care with other colleagues in the health professions, including but not limited to shared care, transfer of care, and/or handover of care to enable continuity and safety in patients with co-morbid chronic pain and depression.
