## Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) Instructor Course Application Form September, 2019

Thank-you for your interest in becoming a Neonatal Resuscitation Program Instructor!

The Canadian Pediatric Society has established eligibility criteria for becoming registered as an NRP Instructor in Canada. The Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) Advisory Committee of Saskatchewan works with interested individuals to ensure that eligibility criteria have been met prior to formal registration and acceptance to the NRP Instructor course. Eligibility criteria includes:

- One of the following: Licensed Physician (Resident or Fellow), Registered Nurse, Registered Respiratory Therapist or Registered Midwife.
- Have a sponsoring institution that supports neonatal resuscitation programming
- Have relevant and ongoing experience in neonatal resuscitation. The Saskatchewan NRP Committee has
  defined this further as having a minimum of 2 years' experience providing obstetrical / neonatal care, and a
  minimum of 2 years' experience as an NRP Provider
- Successfully completed a NRP Provider course with an advanced Individual Integrated Skills Station (ISSA) in the past 24 months.

Completed the 7<sup>th</sup> edition Online Exam within the preceding twelve (12) months of the course. If it has been longer than 12 months, you will need to re-take the exam prior to the course.

Completion of the NRP Instructor Course Application Form, which includes:

- Page 2 Information we require to confirm your eligibility
