<u>Course Overview:</u> The course was developed out of an inter disciplinary conference focused on mental health, complex pain and substance use disorders.

<u>Target Audience</u>: This course is suitable for family physicians, specialist physicians, nurses, nurse practitioners, mental health professionals, pharmacists, physiotherapists, residents, researchers, health sciences students, and other health care professionals.

Course Learning Objectives: Upon completion of this course, the learner will be able to:

- Describe pharmacological and non-pharmacological treatment options for the management of chronic pain including identifying coverage for commonly prescribed medications and describing the safe taper of medication.
- Examine culturally safe and trauma-informed pain care through an Indigenous lens.
- Explain the management of patients with a dual diagnosis of addiction and chronic pain.
